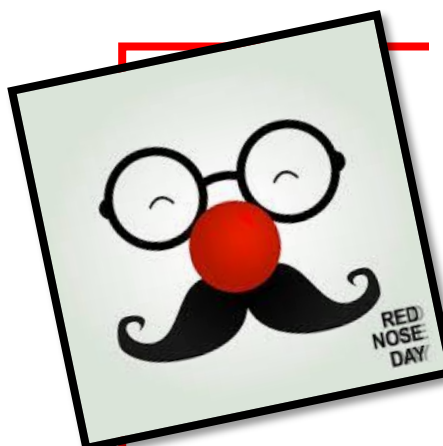
Pi day is on Monday and there are two competitions!
