- 2. **Sex and Relationships.** There have been many lines written in the press and coverage on the TV about the changes that schools have to make and what they are teaching concerning sex and relationships. As a parent I understand the concerns so let me be clear about what is happening:
 - There is no change in what we are teaching this year it is the same as we have done for 4 years.
 - The suggested changes from the Government are due to be implemented in September 2020.
 - We have drafted a policy which is being considered by Governors this term. If approved we will then produce the curriculum coverage that we propose to deliver.
 - I will consult with parents the policy and curriculum will be sent home and made available for parents.
 - Parents will be invited to a meeting to discuss with my Senior Teachers, the leader of Health Education at the school and myself.
 - We will listen closely to your views.
 - I will not allow anything that is not "age appropriate" to be taught at Flora Gardens.
 - I will not accept discrimination of any kind at Flora Gardens.
 - We will continue to deliver the National Curriculum.
 - My door will remain open to discuss this or any other educational matters.
 - Your rights as parents:
 - Parents do not have the right to withdraw pupils from relationships education.
 - Parents have the right to withdraw their child from some aspects of sex education.

Again, let me make it clear that nothing will be taught without full consultation and nothing will be taught that is not age appropriate.

I hope that puts your mind at ease.
