It has been a while since I have updated you on the proposed redevelopment and I hope to have more regular news over the coming weeks.

We have interviewed a number of architects with the Local Authority and now selected a company to design the school. At present it remains commercially sensitive but I expect to be able to share with you the name of them in the next few weeks. They are in the process of outlining their engagement ideas and setting dates of meetings. I expect us to be able to share ideas and concepts with the local community and parents in December, subject to the General Election allowing this to happen. The architects will be working with Governors, School staff and pupils in the meantime.


