Well done, Year 6!



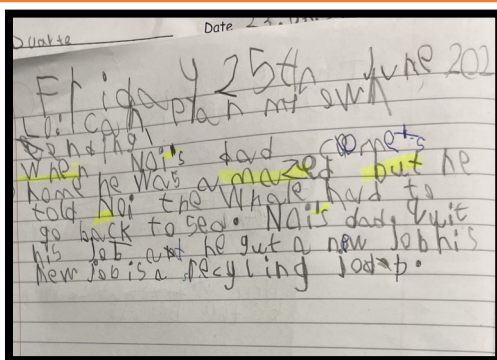
