The afterschool clubs and activities brochure will be going live on Pay360 today at 4pm. www.pay360education payments.com.


The clubs are all free and will begin on Monday 12th September. If your child does not attend a club for more than two weeks in a row the place will be allocated to another pupil.

Nethercott House Trip

There are still places available for the residential trip to Nethercott House in October 2022.

Please remember to label your child's uniform and water bottle. If it's labelled it can be returned to them.



Breakfast Club

Breakfast club runs daily, from 7.30am, where a cooked breakfast is provided for Reception - Year 6. You do not need to book, so you can turn up and pay on the day! The cost of breakfast club is £1.50 per day (reduced to 50p per day if your child is in receipt of free school meals) and will be payable online via Pay360 or in cash.

Afterschool Service

Our After School Service runs from 4.30pm - 6.00pm, although you are welcome to pick your child up any time in between. Pupils will have a snack and drink and various supervised games and activities take place - plus opportunities to complete homework. The cost is £10 per day, and a reduction of £7.50 for siblings, and can be used on an ad-hoc basis. There are discounts offered for booking regular sessions for a whole half term in advance - details can be received from the school office.

Pay360

Use Pay360 to pay for After School Service, lunches and trips and to book a place on after school clubs.

- Go to the site: <u>www.pay360education</u> <u>payments.com.</u>
- Select the site you wish to use, either Facebook, Google, etc
- Enter the invitation code sent from the school – it will link to your child's account
- You will be asked to confirm your child's details
- You can book the afterschool service (please let us know if you book for the same day)
- After school clubs once you have chosen the club/s, remember to check out your basket to confirm your child's place - even though they are free.

School Meals

The cost of a school meal is £1.95 per day. £9.75 per week. You can pay via www.pay360education.payments.com. If you need any help logging in please contact the school office. The menu is available on our website. If you are experiencing any difficulties with paying please let us know so we can help.

Universal Free School Meals

All Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils can enjoy a school meal without charge every day irrespective of income. However, you will still have to register if you are entitled to Free School Meals - this is very important for the school's funding. (Nursery pupils are not included in the UFSM scheme)
