

Literacy:

- Enjoys rhyming activities.
- Listens and joins in with stories and poems.
- Gives meanings to marks they draw, write and paint.
- Links sounds to letters of the alphabet.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Demonstrates friendly behaviour with new peers and can play with others.
- Can select and use activities and resources with help.
- Aware of own feelings, and knows that some actions and words can hurt others' feelings.
