

English:

S&L: Answering questions in full sentences, oral rehearsal for writing, listening to alien music and discussing it. Drama linked to PSHE/PE dancing.

R: Non-fiction planet fact-files, narrative alien stories.

W: Narrative story writing linked to 'Aliens Love Underpants.'
Non-fiction descriptive writing of an alien planet – imaginative writing.

Geography (Ge1/1.2a, 1/1.3a)

- Understanding local area features & physical/human geography of the local area.
- Studying an 'alien habitat' (desert or Antarctica) and identifying seasonal and weather patterns and features and their location in relation to Poles.

PSHE & PE:

- Interpretive alien dance (trust as a team)
- Creating aliens music (respecting emotions)

Science (Sc1/2.2d)

- Identifying body parts (aliens and humans) and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
- Creating own aliens with body parts.
